


What is a Private Branch Exchange (PBX)?



A PBX is a telephone system within an enterprise that switches calls between enterprise users on local lines while allowing all users to share a certain number of external phone lines.

What is a Key System?



A key system is a multiline telephone **system** typically used in business environments, encompassing **systems** ranging from small **key** telephone **systems** to large-scale private branch exchanges.
