


Panopto

View Video Statistics

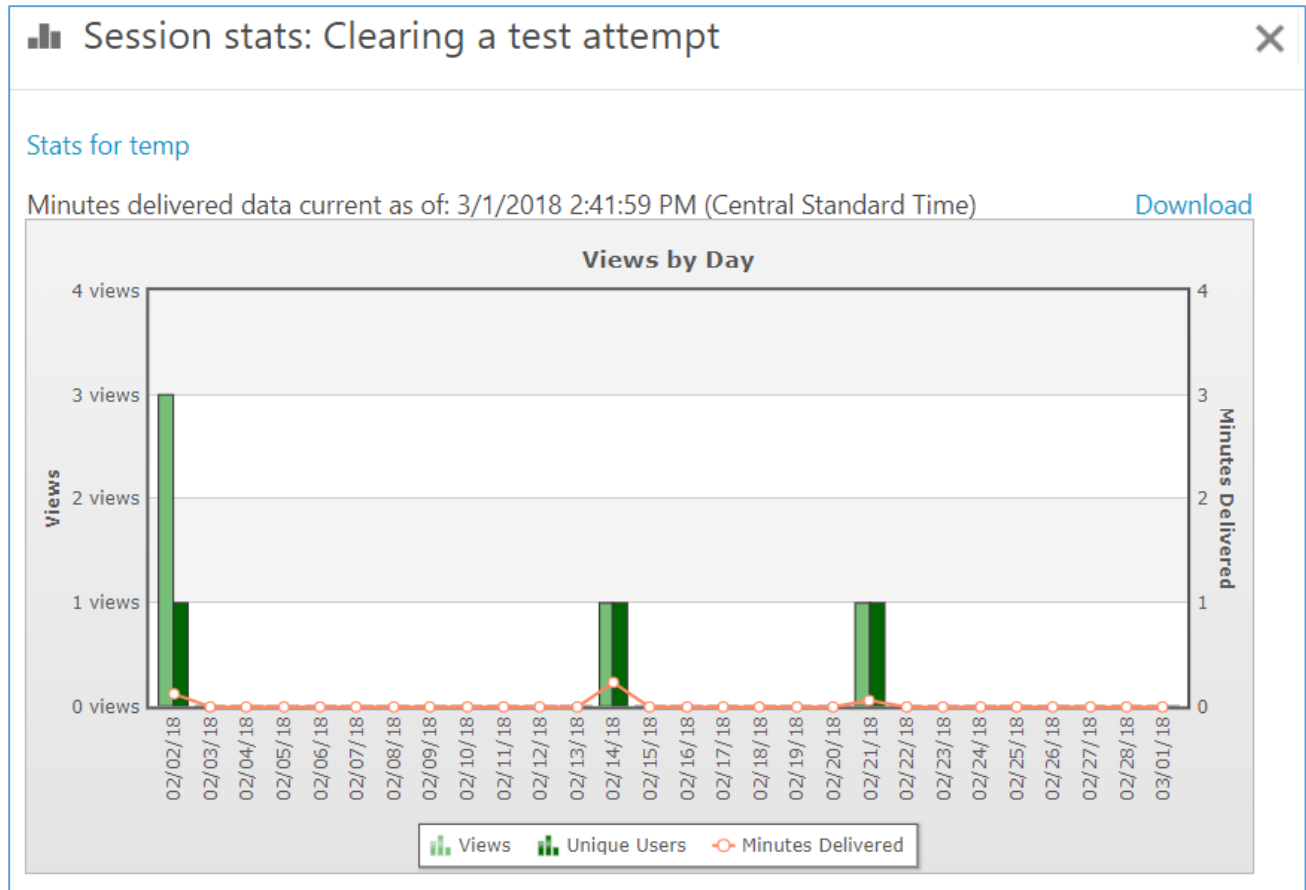
One of the major benefits of Panopto is the ability to track statistics on videos posted in the system. Instructors can view statistics on which students watched the videos, how much of the video was watched, and number of times the video was watched.

1. To view statistics on a video, log into Panopto and locate your video
2. Click on the “Stats” button below the video name

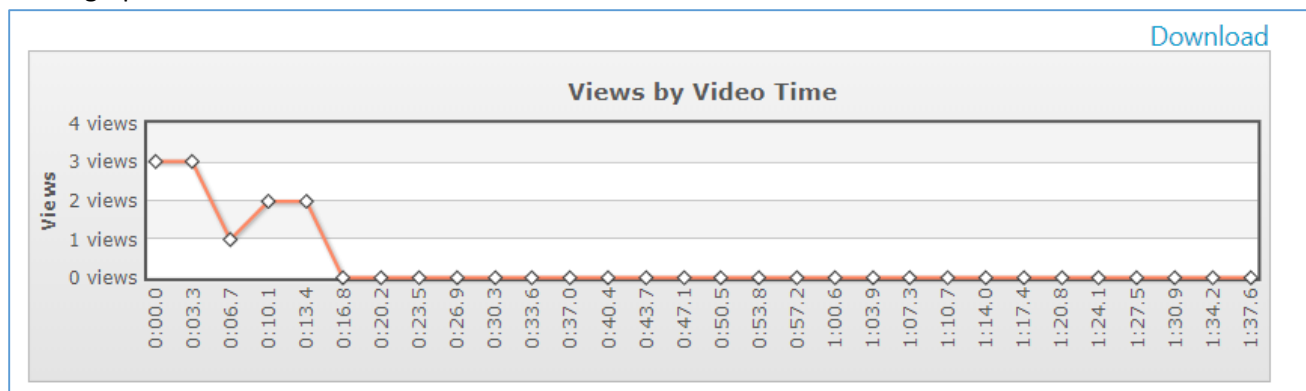

4. You can also see if students are watching the video all the way to the end by looking at the “Views by Video Time” graph

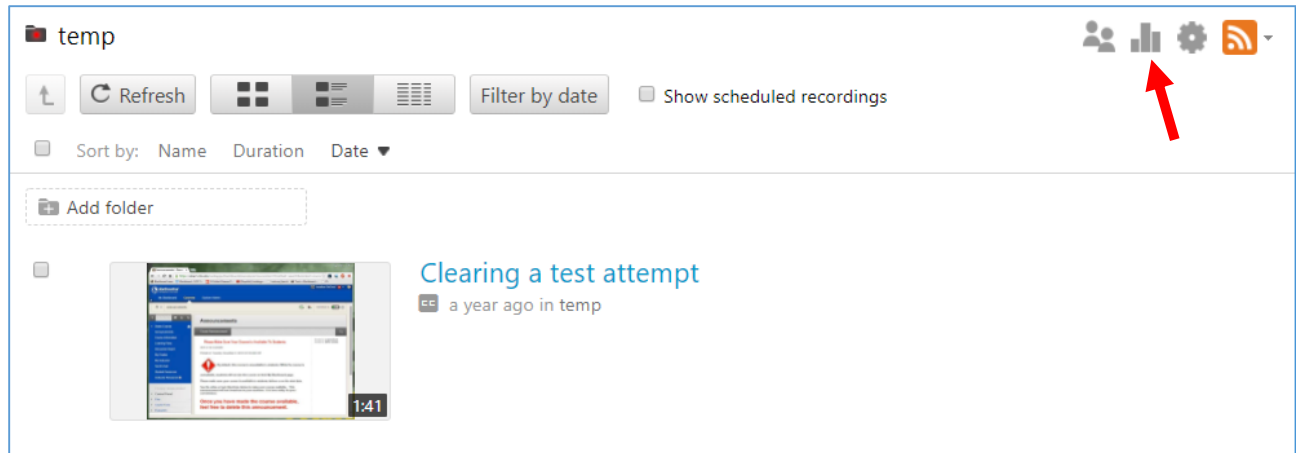


5. You can also change the exact date range for which the statistics are shown
