Adding Collaborate Menu Item in Blackboard

Starting with the Spring 2016 Semester, all computer conference courses will be populated with a new menu item which can be used to access Blackboard Collaborate. If teaching a course that is not officially a computer conference course but wish to utilize this tool, it can be added by following the directions below.

1. Hover over the plus icon  located above the standard NTC menu. Click on **Tool Link**.
2. The **Add Tool Link** box will display. Enter **Join Web Conference** in the Name field, select **Blackboard Collaborate Scheduling Manager** for **Type** and select **Available to Users**. Click **Submit**.

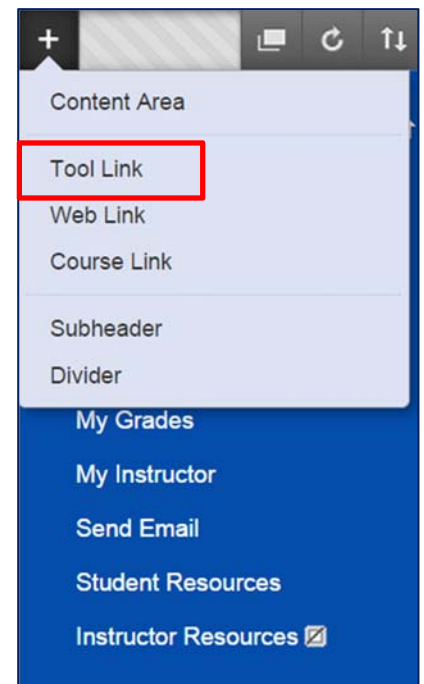

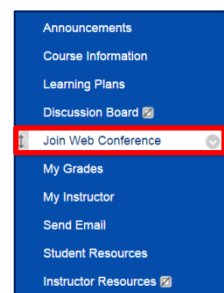
