

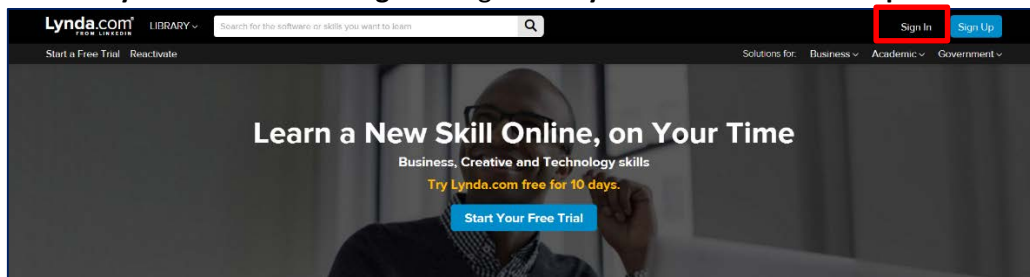
Embedding Lynda.com Videos in Blackboard

Embed YouTube Videos in a Blackboard Item

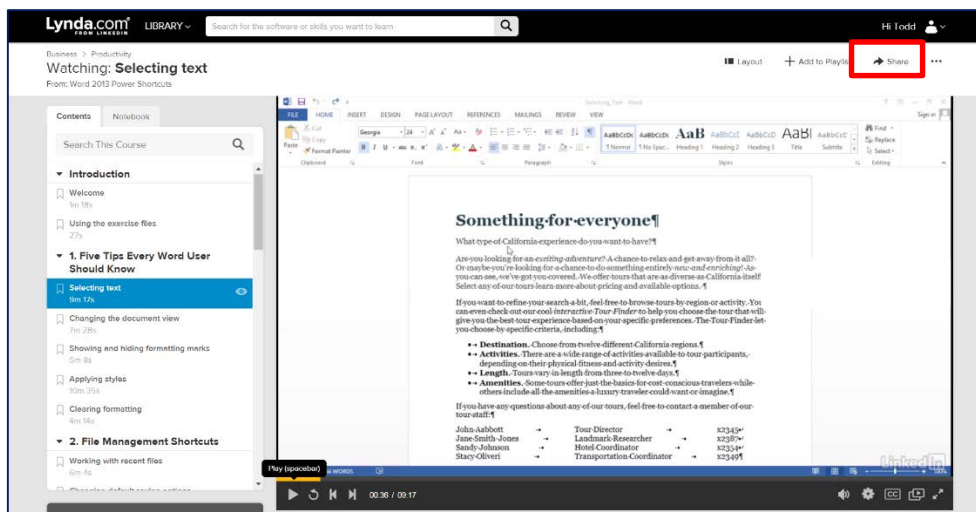
NTC's Lynda.com subscription means students and faculty have access to view thousands of instructional videos. This access also allows faculty to embed these videos directly into Blackboard courses. When Lynda.com videos are embedded into a course, users are not required to leave the Blackboard environment creating a seamless experience for students. **Students must be logged into their NTC student email to view the videos.** Instructors can sign in to Lynda.com directly with their Blackboard username and password.

To embed Lynda.com videos into a Blackboard course, follow the directions below.

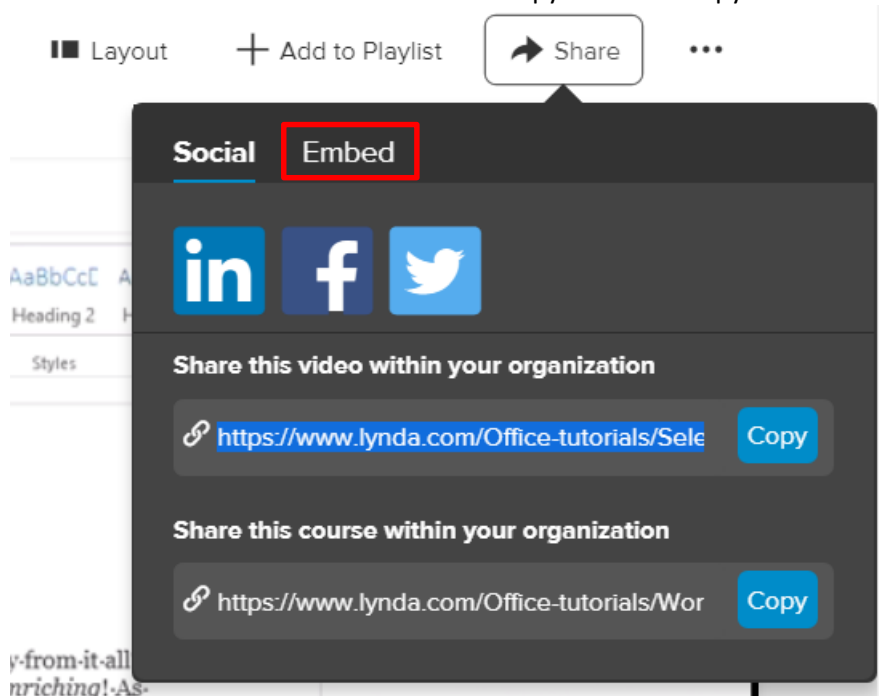
1. Go to **Lynda.com** and click **Sign In**. Log in with your **NTC username and password**.



2. Once logged in, search for the software or skill you want to share with your students.
3. Browse through the content related to your search until you find the video(s) you would like to embed.
4. To embed a video, click on the **Share** button near to the top of the screen.



4. Click the **Embed** tab and then click the copy button to copy the code that appears in the share pop up window.

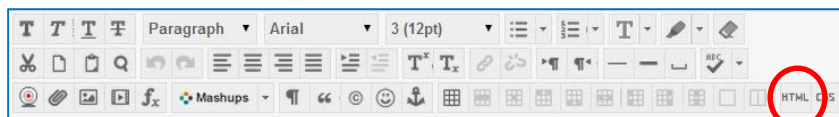


5. Access the Blackboard course the video will be embedded in. Click the Content Area (most likely **Announcements** or **Learning Plans**) where you wish to post the video.

6. Hover over Build Content and click on **Item**.

7. Provide a name for the Item.

8. In the edit menu of the text field, click on the **HTML** icon.



9. The HTML code view page will display.

10. Paste the Lynda.com embed code into the text field. (Ctrl+V or right-click + Paste)

11. Click **Update**. The HTML code view will close and you will notice a yellow box in the text editor.

12. Click **Submit**.

13. The embedded video will now display in your Blackboard course display.

14. **Remember to let students know they need to be logged into their NTC Student email in order to view Lynda.com videos.**
